Alan & Suzanne Osmond – The founders and Chairman and President of One Heart, a charitable organization which supports projects and organizations benefitting millions around the world. Alan is the oldest of the performing Osmond Brothers. He and Suzanne are busy with One Heart and their family promoting website, thefamily.com. They will speak at our evening reception on the need to strengthen families and the importance of both mothers and fathers in rearing children.

Jack Thompson – Attorney, Author and Crusader in the fight against material harmful to minors. Jack has taken on the issues of pornography, obscenity in music and radio, and has become the nation's foremost authority on the effects of violent video games, as documented in his book, "Out of Harm's Way". He will be talking about the research proving exposure to graphic violence leads to violent children and this year's legislation to prevent it.

Senator Randy Brogdon – One of the most conservative Legislators in Oklahoma. Senator Brogden played a key role in Oklahoma's illegal immigration crackdown and is an authority on NAFTA (North American Free Trade Agreement) and SPP (Security & Prosperity Partnership), both threats to our National Sovereignty!

Congressman Rob Bishop – A public school teacher turned public servant. Congressman Bishop served 16 years in the Utah State Legislature, including a term as Speaker of the House, before being elected to Represent Utah's 1st Congressional District. He will speak on the energy crisis and ways to make the U.S. Energy independent.

Orlean Koehle – President of Eagle Forum of California. Orlean is a published author on a wide variety of subjects including the dangers of the Real ID.

Senator Chris Butters – Utah State Senator - District 10. Chris is considered a controversial figure in the Legislature because of his courage to stand up for what is right and to sponsor and support bills that are no longer politically correct. He will give us a run-down of what to expect in the 2009 Legislative Session.

Representative Chris Herrod – Utah State Representative for District 62. Chris has always been interested in International Affairs and has traveled the world as a student, a performer and a teacher. He will be speaking about the current efforts at illegal immigration reform in the state of Utah.

Representative Carl Wimmer – Utah State Representative for District 52. Carl is a former police officer and currently owns a security/self defense company. He is committed to Right-to-Life and is sponsoring pro-life legislation this year. He will be speaking about the strategy for success in getting all of the pro-life bills passed.

Cherilyn Eagar – Education Policy Analyst and Advocate. Clark Aposhian – Utah State and NRA certified firearms instructor. Clark chairs several boards related to guns and gun rights, including the Utah Shooting Sports Council. He will be speaking about what we can expect from the Obama Presidency backed by a Democrat Congress relating to our Right to Keep and Bear Arms.

Scott Bradley – Founder of the annual Constitution Day celebration in Logan, Utah. Scott is a well known speaker and author of "To Preserve the Nation" and "Turn to the Constitution." He is our returning authority on the Constitution and the intent of its founders.
